The Minnesota Waiver Healthcare Common Procedure Coding System (HCPCS) Codes enable Case Managers to provide indirect support for client health by helping clients live more confidently and independently at home. Each of these codes were selected by HealtheMed to work together in a technology system that is installed in each client's home or residence.

\***S5165** For the BI, CAC, CADI, and DD waivers, the environmental accessibility adaptations (EAA) service covers approved monitoring technology equipment and 24x7 client monitoring services that are not shared (i.e., it would follow the person if/when they move). EAA includes the assessments necessary to determine the most appropriate equipment, and installation, maintenance and repairs of the equipment.

\*\***T2029** For the BI, CAC, CADI, and DD waivers, the assistive technology service covers specialized equipment and supplies [automated pill dispensers]. Assistive technology/equipment unit rates include the rental or purchase of an assistive device or software, maintenance and repair of the assistive device and training and evaluation about the product.

\*\*\***S5110** For the B1, CAC, CADI, and DD waivers (**S5115 for EW**), the home care training, family service covers clients and caregiver training provided in the home and remotely by registered nurses and public health nurses licensed under Minn. Stat. §148.171 to 148.28. And, by specialized service providers who are also licensed as Minnesota MHCP providers and supervised by registered nurses for AC and EW clients.
